Cooking with Honey, Beekeeping Crafts, and Beekeeping Photography Contest 2017

The Missouri State Beekeepers Association will host the "Cooking with Honey, Beekeeping Art, and Beekeeping Photography" contest at the 2018 Spring Conference. If you are a member or spouse of a member of the MSBA, please show off your unique cooking, crafting, and photography talents and represent your local club with pride.

All items must be checked in with Erin on Friday March 2nd no later than 11:30 AM.

Category 1 - "Cooking with Honey"

The classes in this category are:

1. Cookies & Candy
2. Jams, Jellies, Fruit Spread (Must Bring Crackers or bread for people to try jam on)
3. Cake & Pie

1. Honey must be the principal sweetener in recipes
2. Boxed cake mix is not applicable
3. You **MUST** have a typed or printed copy of your recipe with your entries
4. ***Points will be given for your display presentation***
5. Mark your containers with your name if you want them back unless they are disposable
6. **ITEMS THAT NEED REFRIGERATION ARE NOT ALLOWED**
7. The "People's Choice Contest" follows the professional judging, so please bring a generous amount of your food item.

Category 2 - "Honeybee Arts & Crafts"

This category is for honeybee crafts, which includes but is not limited to crochet, knit, embroidery, quilting, painting, jewelry, leatherwork etc.

1. Beekeeping/honeybees should be the subject for all projects
2. We are limited on space so please be considerate of the size of your projects
3. You are responsible for picking your projects up by the end of the conference!!
4. Limit 3 entries per person

Category 3- "Beekeeping Photography"

1. Photos must depict a beekeeping theme including but not limited to bees, beekeepers, hives, honey, brood, etc. in the photos.
2. Photos can be in color or black and white. Those that have been digitally altered beyond basic editing and toning will not be accepted.
3. Limit 3 photos per person
4. Photos must have been taken within the last 2 years
5. Can Not re-enter the same photo used in previous MSBA Photography Contest
6. Photos must be in printed form. They may be mounted, framed, or in protective plastic sleeve
7. Your name must be on the back or attached to the photo in some way
8. You are responsible for picking your photos up.
